## **NEW BUSINESS**

- 1. **Master Plan Amendment for Future Land Use Map** The Commission discussed adding two (2) Commercial areas and five (5) additional areas for Industrial/Extraction. Also, two (2) large areas will be changed to Conservation as the property is designated wetlands.
- 2. **Zoning Amendment for Outdoor Wood Furnaces** Fran Brink presented a proposed zoning amendment. She had done research and made some proposed changes and additions to present language. A **motion** to proceed with the proposed zoning amendment for section 1826 was made by J. Rau, **supported** by F. Sterns.

3. **Rezoning of Two Properties** - One (1) proposed rezoning is a former furniture store located on US 23 N that is presently vacant. It would be changed from R-2 to B-2. Several businesses have been housed in this building. Discussed changing the property near EZ Way Store, formerly Oven Fresh Bakery at Walter and Raymond Street, to B-2. Also, change the Nature Preserve and Prospect Parks from WR to Conservation.
